
OPTIONAL Mounting to Drywall or Thicker Surface Materials




1a - Decide on the location of your ShotShelf mounting tab.

1b - Mark the center for the 2 mounting holes. For best results, feel free to use a level.


DRYWALL Mounting:

Using a 3/16" inch drill bit, drill hole at the previously marked center holes.

WOOD Mounting:

For best practice, predrill 1/8" inch holes to depth of 1/2".

DRYWALL Mounting:

Insert plastic drywall anchors into pre-drilled holes and lightly hammer until flush with drywall.

WOOD Mounting:

This step can be skipped.



Using a Phillips head screw driver and the screws provided, attach the mounting tab. With clockwise rotation, lightly screw into mounting tab chamfer until you feel the mounting tab press against the mounting surface.

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN!
